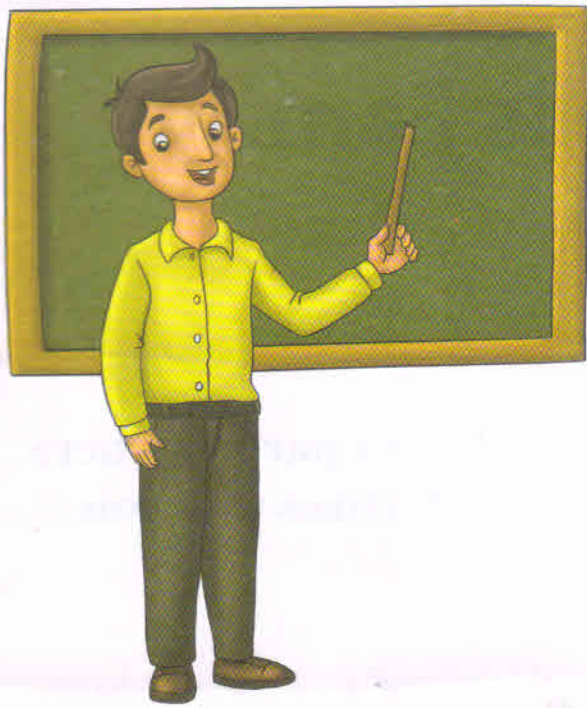

This is Manu.

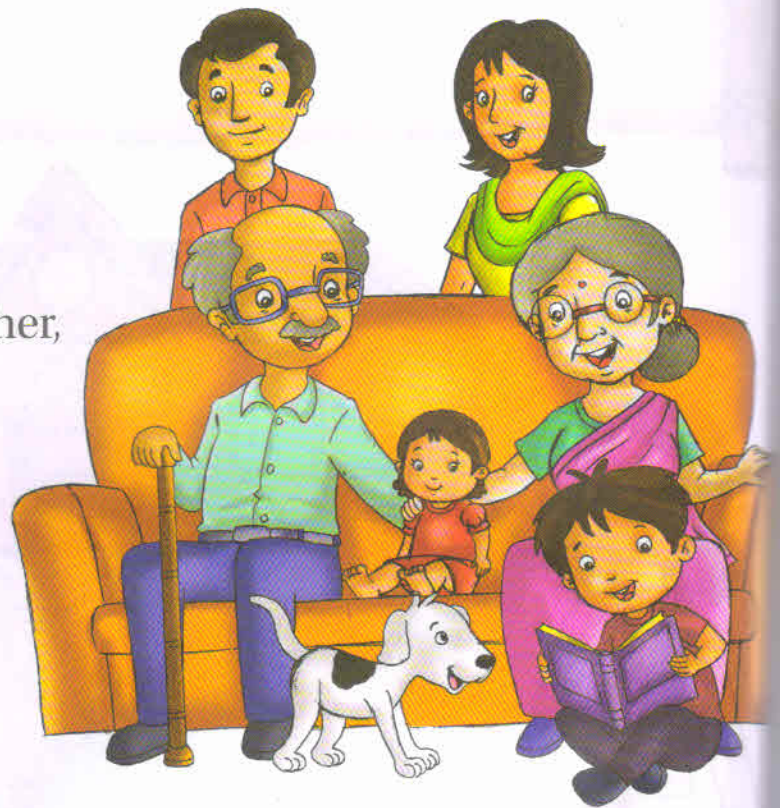
He lives in Ranchi. This is Manu's house.

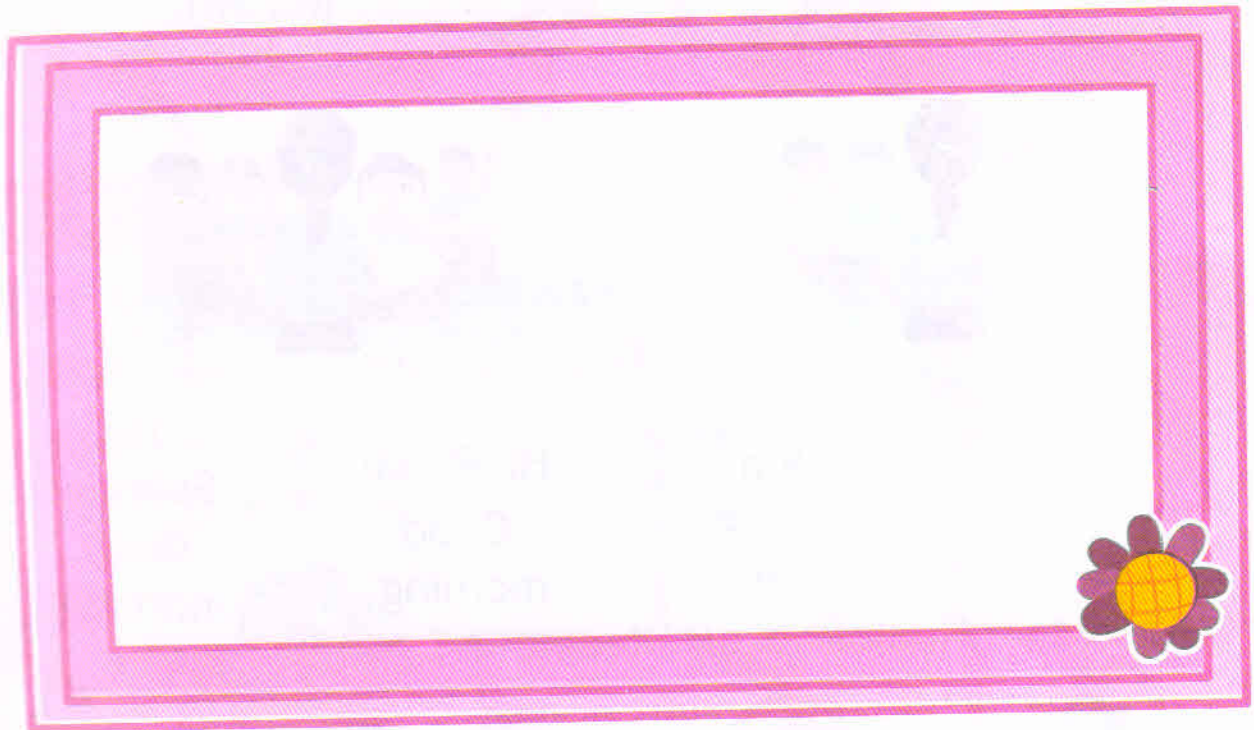
